

Prior to Surgery

Do not eat or drink anything for 8 hours prior to your surgery. This includes water, gum, candy, etc.

Please follow these instructions as they are very important for your safety. Failing to do so will result in the delay, cancelling and/or rescheduling of your surgery.

Morning of Surgery

Please arrive one hour prior to your scheduled surgery time. Upon arrival, you will be asked to complete admission forms and sign consents.

Prior to your surgery, you will meet with the Anesthesiologist, Pre-Operative Nurse and Surgeon, and will have the opportunity to ask any last minute questions.

Leave all valuables at home, including jewelry, contact lenses, etc.

Wear loose, comfortable clothing that is easily removed for your convenience.

Transportation the day of surgery is necessary; you may not drive yourself home. It is imperative that you have an adult 18 years or older to escort you home after your procedure. For your safety, we will not discharge you from the surgery center unaccompanied.

Please arrange for a responsible adult to remain with you during the first night postoperatively.

You will receive a phone call from our Nursing Staff from one week up to the day before your surgery. **Please call the office if you do not receive a call the day before surgery.**

Things to Remember

- ◆ **Be sure to bring a photo ID and insurance card.**
- ◆ Should you have specific questions regarding your surgical procedure, please contact your surgeon's office.
- ◆ **Bring all of your routine medications including Herbs, Vitamins, Supplements, and Over the Counter medications with you on the day of your surgery.**
- ◆ If you experience a change in your health, such as a fever, please notify your doctor prior to surgery.
- ◆ **Remember: Do not eat or drink anything for 8 hours prior to your surgery.**
